Works published in open access repositories are cited more frequently than those that reside only behind a paywall.

### Permalink.

The URL of your article will not change. Share it with anyone via your website, c.v., email, or in any way you like. Download statistics are emailed to you monthly.

### Author rights.

Assert your copyright ownership. Retain your right to freely and legally share your research.

### Visibility.

Broadcast your research to the widest possible audience.

## More about Journal Articles...

### Past Publications

- Many journal publishers (65%) allow authors to self-publish in institutional repositories.
- Publishers may allow authors to post the publisher's pdf, the post-print (post-refereeing), and/or the pre-print (pre-refereed manuscript).
- Ask a librarian ([cupola@gettysburg.edu](mailto:cupola@gettysburg.edu)) or check SHERPA/RoMEO ([www.sherpa.ac.uk/romeo](http://www.sherpa.ac.uk/romeo)) for more detail on a specific journal's policy.

### Future Publications

- BEFORE you sign a contract with a publisher, read it carefully. Don't sign away your copyright without fully understanding the implications.
- Consider using the SPARC Author Addendum to legally modify the publisher's agreement and retain key rights to your work, so that you may deposit it in *The Cupola*.
