Professor Jocelyn Swigger called the meeting to order at 4:03 pm.

She briefly explained the reason for the meeting: to help the Academic Policy and Program Committee and the Chairpersons Council get a sense of the faculty's perceptions of the curriculum, of whether it needs a sustained review, and of how it might be modified to best serve our students. During round-table discussions, groups of about eight people were asked to come up with answers to the following questions:

What skills and qualities do we want our students to graduate with?

Is the curriculum giving those skills and qualities to our students?

How is it meeting or falling short of our goals?

What concrete improvements could we make to the curriculum?

What else would you like to add?

Professor Swigger asked that, following introductions, the different groups spend about fifteen minutes on each question. She said that people were free to treat the questionnaires on each table as they see fit. They could be used to provide talking points; they could provide brief overviews of the various discussions; individuals might want to fill out the forms on their own and direct them to either of the committees that have requested the meeting.

She adjourned the meeting at 5:02 pm.
