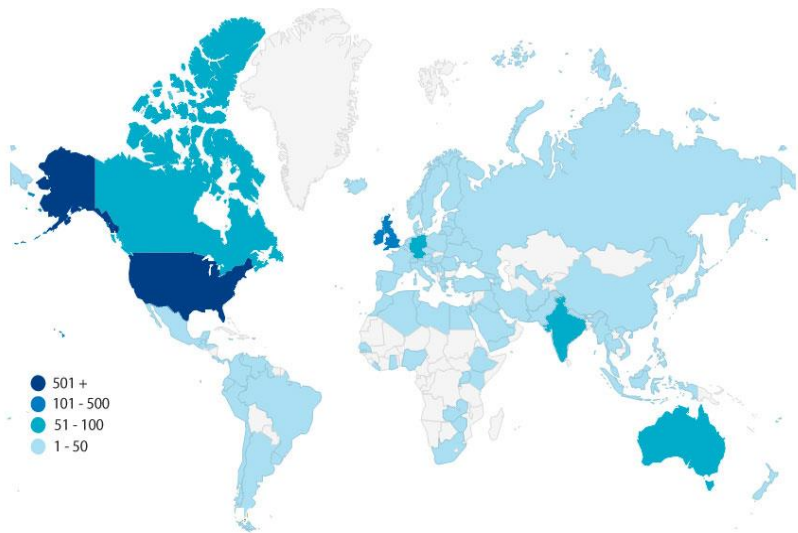

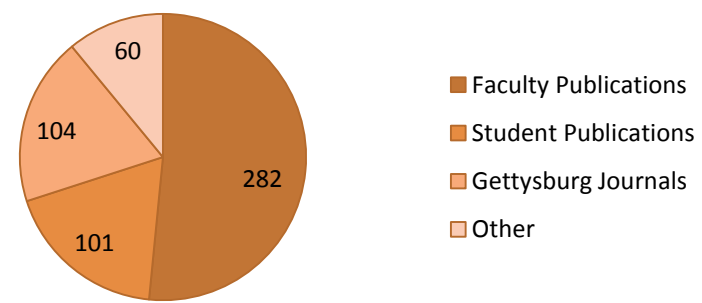


GLOBAL REACH
